1. Event venue

7. Currency/exchange rates/credit cards

National currency unit in the Republic of Azerbaijan is manat (AZN). Credit cards are accepted for payments in banks, large hotels, and shops.

As of 5 July 2018, AZN exchange rate was as following:

1 USD = 1.70 AZN, 1 EURO = 1.99 AZN.

8. Banks

Banks are open from 9:00 till 19:00, Monday to Saturday. Currency exchange is carried out by all banks and exchange offices. Exchange offices are open all days of the week.

9. Climate

The climate of Baku is soft continental. In September, the average daily temperature is + 26.6 C°, average night temperature is + 24.9 C°.

10. Time

Time in Azerbaijan is 4 hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+4).

6. Communication tools

In the event venue, participants will be provided with the Internet access.

Telephone code of Baku is +998 71. For international calls from Baku, one should dial 00 + code of the country + code of the city or follow the instructions on telephone card.

9. Electricity

The standard supply is 220 V/ 50 Hz, third party adapter. In the hotels, electric points with standard supply of 220 V are used.

11. Visa

Participants should apply for visa information to Consulate of the Republic of Azerbaijan in their country well in advance. Those participants who need **a visa** to enter the Republic of Azerbaijan are kindly requested to fill in Visa Support Form (Annex 5) and send it along with copy of the passport to the event coordinator Fuad Mushtag oglu Mushtagov at email: International-fm@mincom.gov.az by 6 August 2018.
