

- CBS-2016 was held in Nairobi, Kenya, from
 5-8 September 2016
- 440 participants from 46 countries
- A session was reserved for ITU CoEs (five CoEs made presentations)
- Exhibition showcasing capacity building projects across the world
 - Only four CoEs from a network of 32 made use of their regional exhibition stand
