Because we wanted to help public administrations to increase the accessibility level in their websites.



- Accessibility Community. Virtual meeeting point







Royal Decree 1112/2018, of 7th September, on accessibility of websites and mobile applications in the public sector.

Scope	Organizational
 ✓ ALL PUBLIC sector included Schools, kindergarten, industrial and commercial, broadcasters (website), etc. ✓ PRIVATE sector services if a PSB is paying it. ✓ Fewer exceptions for content Pre-recorded multimedia prior to 2018 	 ✓ Feedback mechanism. ■ Two models: informal and formal ✓ Units responsible for accessibility. ■ Enforcement near the PSB. ■ Compulsory internal reviews. ✓ Accessibility statements. ■ Access standardized in every website.
Most requisites apply since September 2018	Web Accessibility Observatory becomes compulsory

Lessons Learnt

- ✓ Web accessibility is not only a problem of legislation but of education.
 - All actors involved in PSB but also in companies, students, etc.
- ✓ Accessibility must be transversal to the organization.
 - Only managed from ICTs units will not get a success.
- ✓ Periodic monitoring/reporting is essential to maintain accessibility.
 - The process should always include feedback.
- ✓ All actions must be designed considering final managers of websites.
 - Managers are the critical actors.

Awareness, training, help and monitoring must build a continuous cycle for improving.







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
