Update of e-Submission system - introduction of the new status “Published in BR IFIC”

The Radiocommunication Bureau is pleased to announce that the new status “Published in BR IFIC” has been introduced on the ITU web interface “e-Submission of satellite network filings”.

When a notice is published in a special section or Part I-S in accordance with the Radio Regulations on a BR IFIC (Space Services), the status of the notice on e-Submission will change from “Published As-Received” to “Published in BR IFIC”.

Please note that once a notice is published in a BR IFIC (Space Services), the information concerning that notice, including characteristics of the network and the findings should be consulted in the respective SRSxxx.mdb, IFICxxx.mdb, SPS_ALL_IFICxxx.mdb and 30B_xxxx.mdb available on that BR IFIC. Hence, the information in the [“As Received” website](#) will be removed when the notice will be published in the BR IFIC.

This new status is applicable to all notice types in e-Submissions with the exception of SpaceCom comments.

All notices submitted via e-Submission and already published in BR IFIC (Space Services) to date have been changed to this new status of “Published in BR IFIC”.
