



General aspects -GE06 Agreement-

- Entry into force: 17 June 2007
 - Provisionally as of 17 June 2006
- Frequency Bands:
 - 174-230 MHz
 - 470-862 MHz
- Plans:
 - GE06D: for Digital entries;
 - GE06A for Analogue assignments; and
 - GE06L List for assignments of Other Primary Services










Planning Area – GE06-



Planning area: Region 1 (parts of Region 1 situated to the west of meridian 170° E and to the north of parallel 40° S, except the territory of Mongolia) and in the Islamic Republic of Iran







Basic definitions

- Plans: No 1.10 of article $1 \rightarrow$ §3.1 of article 3
 - Digital: T-DAB and DVB-T assignments and allotments (planning:1.3.1 of Chapter 1 to Annex 2)
 - Analogue: Assignments
- List:
 - OPS Nos.1.14 and 1.15 of Art.1
 - Description of OPS systems Chapter 4, Annex 2
















Linked assignments (At least two stations)










Allotment type 3 and 4- Converted assignments



 - Define if the assignment is in conformity:




No coordination information is necessary

 ☑ The submissiom to comply should be clearly mentioned




Conformity examination GE06D case

Specific case: Submission of assignments stemming from an allotment being modified: Part A10 of Rules of procedures:





Publication process–Article 4





Specific features of coordination procedure

- No reply = no agreement
- Agreement (art4) can be provided for a **defined** duration
- No possibility to delete the remarks from the Plan entries in Article 4
- Deletion of the proposed modification of the Plans if not recorded after 24 months and 75 days
- at the end of the transition period
 - All analogue assignments will be deleted
 - All Plan remarks with respect to analogue will cease to apply







Specific features of coordination procedure

No reply?	Temporary Agreement? (art4)	Delete the Plan Remarks?	Proposed modification of the Plans if not recorded after 24 months and 75 days?	End of the transition period?
• No agreement	 for a defined duration 	• Not possible	• Deleted	 All analogue assignments will be deleted All Plan remarks with respect to analogue will be deleted







Transition period

The *Transition period* started on 17 June 2006 at 0001 hours UTC:

 assignments in the analogue Plan (as specified in § 3.1.2 of Article 3) shall be protected.

• The Transition period shall end :

- VHF Band :
 - on **17 June 2015** at 0001 hours UTC;
 - on 17 June 2020 at 0001 hours UTC for the countries listed in GE06 Agreement
- UHF Band :
 - on **17 June 2015** at 0001 hours UTC All countries







After the transition- Plan

All analogue assignments will be deleted from the Plan

All Plan remarks with respect to analogue will cease to apply

GE06 provisions will not be applicable, anymore, to Analogue assignments.

Administrations will be asked about their decision concerning the analogue assignments recorded in the MIFR.






GE06D Plan modification







GE06 Plan modification evolution










Evolution of assignable channels










ASMG Average of assignable
