The "European Maritime Area" is bounded to the north by a line extending along parallel $72^{\circ}$ North from its intersection with meridian $55^{\circ}$ East of Greenwich to its intersection with meridian $5^{\circ}$ West, then along meridian $5^{\circ}$ West to its intersection with parallel $67^{\circ}$ North, thence along parallel $67^{\circ}$ North to its intersection with meridian $32^{\circ}$ West; to the west by a line extending along meridian $32^{\circ}$ West to its intersection with parallel $30^{\circ}$ North; to the south by a line extending along parallel $30^{\circ}$ North to its intersection with meridian $43^{\circ}$ East; to the east by a line extending along meridian $43^{\circ}$ East to its intersection with parallel $60^{\circ}$ North, thence along parallel $60^{\circ}$ North to its intersection with meridian $55^{\circ}$ East and thence along meridian $55^{\circ}$ East to its intersection with parallel $72^{\circ}$ North.
